# Arnošt Lustig Foundation: Personal Data Protection

The Arnošt Lustig Foundation (hereinafter referred to as the “Foundation”) is interested in strict compliance with the legal regulations, which also includes activities aimed at ensuring compliance with the obligations arising for the Foundation under the EU Regulation No 216/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of individuals with regards to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (“GDPR”).

In processing personal data, the Foundation is governed by applicable law and internal directives that define when, to what extent, for how long and under what conditions the Foundation will process personal data.

If it is necessary to obtain personal data of any natural person in the course of the Foundation’s activities, this may be done either on the basis of the law or with the consent of the data subject. Where the consent of the data subject is required for the processing of personal data, personal data will not be processed until the data subject has given unquestionable consent to the processing of personal data and

has been given intelligible notice of the terms of such processing, in particular the reason for, the period of and the manner of processing. The data subject will also be advised of his or her rights, including the right to (i) seek rectification of personal data, (ii) erasure of personal data, (iii) object to processing, (iv) portability of personal data, (v) file a complaint with a supervisory authority, (vi) restriction of processing of personal data and (vii) the right to obtain a copy of the personal data processed.

In any event, however, any personal data shall be processed carefully, securely, only for the specified purpose and for the specified period of time, only in the specified manner and for the specified purpose.

### **Google Analytics**

The Foundation uses Google Analytics, developed and operated by Google Inc., Amphitheatre Parkway, Mountain View, CA 94043, USA (“Google”), to analyse the website using cookies.

The analysis using Google Analytics is performed in such a way that the information about the use of the website generated by the collected cookies is transferred to a Google server in the USA and analysed there. As a result of the IP address anonymisation set up on the operator’s website, the IP address is shortened by Google before the data is transmitted to the Google server in the USA, in a member state of the EU or the European Economic Area. Only in exceptional cases is the full IP address transferred to a Google server in the USA and only there is it shortened (anonymised).

Google will not associate the transmitted data, including the shortened IP address, with other data. Google’s privacy statement can be viewed [here](#).
